Scope and Responsibilities:

To convert the existing surgery center in its St. Lucie West location to a state-of-the-art cancer treatment facility, Martin Memorial Heath Services chose Richard K. Davis Construction Corporation. We were responsible for the entire project including a concrete vault with 5'- 8' thick walls and ceiling built to house the linear accelerator used in radiation treatments. The vault, CAT scan room, doctors' offices, nurses' station, dressing rooms, bathrooms, and reception area all feature custom cabinetry. Work on the project was completed without interfering with the hospital's regular business and met the stringent requirements set forth for the nuclear medical procedures employed.
