The Bonsai Education Pavilion is an ornate structure for outdoor gathering within the largest public display of tropical bonsai in the United States. Its design holds an oriental flair, painstakingly crafted of dimensional pine timbers by master carpenters under Richard K. Davis Construction's employ. A pagoda to house the irrigation pumps/electrical panels and entrance gates into the exhibit were also constructed with architectural detailing to compliment the centerpiece Pavilion structure.
